




Welcome to 5th Grade Mrs. Wheelwright's Class

Homework

Students will be getting a homework packet every Monday. Weekly homework includes math and reading worksheets of concepts we learned that week. There will also be a "Take Home" reading book with a question sheet that goes along with the book. Students are expected to read **30 minutes a night** and work on the questions as they go. Their homework packets and reading questions must be **returned on Friday** so your student can attend the Fun Friday activity.

Assignments

Students must be responsible for their assignments and turn them in when due. Incomplete work will be returned to the student until it is completed. Students must have all assignments completed for the week in order to go to the Fun Friday activity. If your student has missing work they will go to Study Hall instead of Fun Friday.

Attendance

Attendance in school is extremely important. It is important that your student attends school every day. If your student must miss school, please call and inform the school of their absence. Frequent absences or tardies of the students from the day to day classroom experiences disrupt from the instructional and learning process. The benefits of instruction, once lost, are often difficult to regain.

Behavior

In order to create a positive learning environment for each student, students need to have good behavior. During the week, I reward students who are on task and well-behaved with tickets. Each Friday students can use their tickets to get prizes. During the year we will also have special activities and class parties. Students who are well-behaved will be able to attend those activities with the rest of their class. Students who choose to misbehave will be given warning punches on their hole punch card. If students still choose to misbehave they will get more punches, and may not participate in our Fun Friday activity. If your student is continually getting punches on their card, we will all communicate about solutions to help your student be successful.
